As our dependence on the internet, corporate networks, and digital devices has increased, so has the challenge of securing personal information, intellectual property, and critical data. Each year brings with it a new wave of cyberattacks. Cybersecurity is how data, systems, devices and networks are protected from hackers, viruses, malware, and data breaches. Today cybercrime is so sophisticated it seems nearly impossible to prevent. The increase in threats against data systems and breaches of sensitive information has created a need for cybersecurity professionals. These security professionals are constantly asked to increase their level of education, gain new skills, and improve their skills and techniques in response to the increased capabilities of their adversaries.

**TOPIC: MICHIGAN NOTARY RULES  
PRESENTED BY: JENNIFER JOY YOCUM, CLP  
NALS OF MICHIGAN VP OF CLE AND CERTIFICATION**

Jennifer will speak about Michigan's notary laws, including the ups and downs and changes that have occurred during the COVID-19 pandemic. In addition to traditional pen and paper notarization, e-notarizations and remote notarizations under state-approved systems are on the rise. As public servants, notaries must act responsibly and exercise reasonable care in the performance of their official duties. If a notary fails to do so, they may be subject to a civil suit to recover financial damages caused by the notary's error or omission. Complying with all pertinent laws is the first rule of reasonable care for a notary. Did you know that it is a notary's legal responsibility under Michigan's Laws on Notarial Acts, P.A. 238 of 2003, as amended, to read the MiLONA in its entirety before performing a single notarial act? Jennifer will also review the notary prohibitions and the penalties for violations, including civil infractions, misdemeanor convictions and felony convictions.

Jennifer is an Administrative Assistant III with the Legal Regulatory Department at Consumers Energy Company in Lansing, Michigan, where she assists her hard-working attorneys with a variety of tasks relating to utility law, including maintaining and assisting with seeing cases through from beginning to end at the Michigan Public Service Commission, state court, and federal court. Jennifer has over 20 years of legal office experience. She is a former ELA and Social Studies Middle School Teacher, and was certified in the State of Michigan.
